The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SUPERIOR COURT OR THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT BUILDING IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate
2 accommodations in the superior court building at
3 Cambridge, in the county of Middlesex, the county
4 commissioners of said county may alter or remodel
5 and make additions to said building, and furnish and
6 equip said additions and alterations, and do all
7 things incidental thereto.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, the county
2 treasurer of said county, with the approval of the
3 county commissioners, may borrow from time to time,
4 on the credit of the county, such sums as may be
5 necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate one million
6 two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may

7 issue temporary notes of the county therefor, payable
8 in not more than two years from their date or dates
9 of issue. Thereafter the county treasurer of said
10 county, with the approval of the county commis-
11 sioners, may borrow from time to time on the credit
12 of the county such sums as may be necessary to cover
13 the complete cost of the project, not exceeding in the
14 aggregate one million two hundred and fifty thousand
15 dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county
16 therefor, which shall bear on their face the words,
17 Middlesex County Superior Court Improvement Loan,
18 Act of 1953. Each authorized issue shall constitute
19 a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in
20 not more than ten years from their dates. Such
21 bonds or notes shall be signed by the treasurer of the
22 county and countersigned by a majority at least of
23 the county commissioners. The county may sell the
24 said temporary notes, bonds and notes at public or
25 private sale upon such terms and conditions as the
26 county commissioners may deem proper, but not for
27 less than their par value. Securities authorized hereby
28 shall be excepted from the requirement of chapter
29 thirty-five of the General Laws as to advertising for
30 bids. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall,
31 except as herein provided, be subject to chapter
32 thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by the county
3 commissioners of the county of Middlesex.
