### RESOLVE

In favor of Owen Dolan.

1 *Resolved*, That Owen Dolan of Boston, Massachusetts,  
2 father of two sons, now deceased, who served in the war  
3 of the rebellion to the credit of this Commonwealth as  
4 follows:— Hugh Dolan, United States navy, ship “Cir-  
5 cassian”; John Dolan, United States navy, ship “Preble,”  
6 shall, from and after the passage of this resolve, be  
7 eligible to receive state aid under the provisions, rules  
8 and limitations of chapter three hundred and one of the  
9 acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, in  
10 the same manner and to the same extent he would have  
11 been had he drawn state aid prior to the enactment of  
12 chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the acts of the  
13 year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven.
