AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OFFICE OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 section 1 of chapter 151 of the acts of 1975, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph: —
4 Whenever a statement of organization of a political committee is
5 filed on behalf of a candidate who became a candidate after the
6 deadline for filing nomination papers, the director shall at the time
7 of the filing notify the candidate or his representative of the re-
8 quirements of clause (a) of section five of chapter two hundred and
9 sixty-eight B and he shall also forward the name and address of
10 such candidate to the state ethics commission within three days
11 after the filing of a political committee with his office.
