AN ACT EXCLUDING THE SALE OF GASOLINE FROM THE OPERATION OF THE FAIR TRADE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 14A of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as amended
- 2 by chapter 231 of the acts of 1939, is hereby further amended
- 3 by adding at the end the following clause: —
- 4 (4) In the sale of gasoline at service stations from branded
- 5 pumps or dispensers.
