The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE "NO FAULT" AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The amendments to the General Laws contained in chapter 2 670 of the 1970 legislative session are hereby repealed.

As all things are done by the House of Representatives, it is the duty of the House to see that the laws are faithfully executed and that the public interest is promoted.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 8, Clause 18

To make all laws which shall be necessary and proper to carry into execution the foregoing powers, and all other powers vested by this Constitution in the Government of the United States, or in any of the Departments thereof.
