Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

To provide for Operating the North Metropolitan System of Sewerage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing for the
2 cost of the maintenance and operation of the system of
3 sewage disposal for the cities of Boston, Cambridge,
4 Somerville, Malden, Chelsea, Woburn, Medford and
5 Everett, and the towns of Stoneham, Melrose, Win-
6 chester, Arlington and Belmont, known as the north
7 metropolitan system, there shall be allowed and paid out
8 of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
9 forty-six thousand dollars during the year eighteen hun-
10 dred and ninety-five; this sum to be in addition to the
11 amount provided for by chapter one hundred and thirty-
12 one, acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
