By Mrs. Padula, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1877) of Mary L. Padula for legislation to direct the Commonwealth to reimburse the town of Westminster for certain monies expended for veterans' services. Ways and Means (Senate).

AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF WESTMINSTER FOR CERTAIN MONIES EXPENDED FOR VETERANS' SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to
2 the town of Westminster, subject to appropriation and subject
3 to the approval of the commissioner of veterans' services, such
4 sum, not exceeding thirty-seven thousand six hundred seventy-
5 five dollars and no cents, as said town would have been en-
6 titled to receive in reimbursement for veterans' benefits paid
7 by it in fiscal years nineteen hundred and seventy-six, seventy-
8 seven, seventy-eight, seventy-nine, eighty, eighty-one, eighty-
9 two and eighty-three, under the provisions of section six of
10 chapter one hundred and fifteen of the General Laws, had said
11 town made a proper and seasonable report thereof to said
12 commissioner as required by section six.
