By Mr. McCann, petition of Francis X. McCann for legislation to regulate the sale of electrical conduits, apparatus, appliances, fixtures and wires used to carry electricity for light, heat or power purposes. Public Safety.

AN ACT REGULATING THE SALE OF ELECTRICAL CONDUITS, APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, FIXTURES AND WIRES USED TO CARRY ELECTRICITY FOR LIGHT, HEAT OR POWER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and forty-one of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section six the
3 following new section:

4 Section 6A. All electrical conduit, apparatus, appliances,
5 fixtures and wires used or offered for sale to be used in con-
6 nection with any electric wiring for light, heat or power, sig-
7 nalling or other purposes shall be subject to the approval of
8 the State Examiners of Electricians. The listing of any such
9 materials in the "List of Electrical Construction Materials"
10 published by the National Board of Fire Underwriters shall be
11 accepted by the Board of the State Examiners of Electricians
12 as evidence of such approval. Any violation of this section
13 shall be subject to the penalties set forth in section five.
