AN ACT CORRECTING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (1) of section 46 of chapter 30 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the salary
3 schedule, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 210
4 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof the following:—
