AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO PAY AN AMOUNT OF MONEY TO THE ESTATE OF JULIA M. DOYLE FOR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM CERTAIN LAND TAKINGS BY THEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Worcester county
2 are hereby authorized to pay eighteen thousand three hundred
3 dollars as damages to the estate of Julia M. Doyle in connection
4 with the taking by said county commissioners by eminent do-
5 main of a parcel of land owned by the said Julia M. Doyle on
6 Harvard street in the city of Worcester for an addition to the
7 Worcester county court house.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
