AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANONYMOUS DRUG SURVEYS IN GRADES SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND IN STATE COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 70 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Section 11 of Chapter 492 of the Acts of 1974 is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following paragraph.

4 Under the supervision of the Commissioner of Education, a
5 standardized and anonymous survey of the incidence and types of
6 illegal drug use shall be conducted once a year in public schools,
7 grade seven to twelve and in all state colleges.
