AN ACT PROHIBITING THE IMPORTATION INTO THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE PREPARATION KNOWN COMMERCIALY AS "ARRID."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in ^{the} General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No person shall import into the commonwealth for
2 the purpose of sale the deodorant preparation known
3 commercially as "Arrid." Violation of this chapter
4 shall be punished by a fine of not more than five
5 hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more
6 than six months, or both.
