AN ACT REQUIRING THE FILING OF ALL STATE AGENCY REGULATIONS WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is amended by striking out
2 section 37, as appearing in section 1 of Chapter 459 of the acts of
3 1976, and inserting in place thereof the following:

4 *Section 37.* Every department, board, commission, division or
5 authority of the state government or subdivision of any of the
6 foregoing, or official of the state government, authorized by law to
7 make regulations, shall comply with the filing provisions of section
8 five of chapter thirty A and such regulations shall not take effect
9 until so filed.
