In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Treasurer of the County of Essex to compensate Charles Leighton and Horace M. Sargent for Services as Associate Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county treasurer of the
2 county of Essex is hereby authorized to pay from
3 any funds in the county treasury to Charles
4 Leighton of Lynn, in said county, and to Horace
5 M. Sargent of Haverhill, in said county, an
6 amount not to exceed ten dollars per day for ac-
7 tual services performed by them as associate
9 commissioners for the county of Essex during the
8 year nineteen hundred and twenty.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
