DECISION

Marinesi, Inc. dba Fratelli's Trattoria & Pizzeria (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on September 21, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jan Kujawski.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On, June 17, 2010 at approximately 7:51 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Marinesi, Inc. dba Fratelli's Trattoria.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Bud Light Bottle for \$3.50. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee has no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
