AN ACT PERMITTING A STAY OF JUDGMENT AND EXECUTION IN CERTAIN ACTIONS OF SUMMARY PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. So long as this act continues to be
2 operative, a stay of judgment and execution not to
3 exceed fourteen days may be granted under sections
4 nine to thirteen, inclusive, of chapter two hundred
5 and thirty-nine of the General Laws, in any action of
6 summary process where a tenancy has been terminated
7 by a notice to quit for non-payment of rent, notwith-
8 standing the contrary provisions of said section nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become inoperative on
2 March thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.
