## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

### AN ACT DEALING WITH PROPERTY OWNED BY PUBLIC OR QUASI PUBLIC AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Any or every parcel of land presently owned by any public
- 2 or quasi public authority that has not been in use in at least
- 3 one year shall be sold to the city or town for the purpose of
- 4 constructing a home at the cost of acquisition or recreational
- 5 facility.

The Committee on the subject of the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of New York, in relation to the right of suffrage, have the honor to report to the House of Representatives, as follows:

The Constitution of the State of New York

Article IV, Section 1, Paragraph 1

That the right of suffrage shall be enjoyed by every male citizen of the State of New York, who is twenty-one years of age, and who has resided in this State for one year next preceding the day of the election.
