Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

Relating to Sewers in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter four hundred and  
2 two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
3 two is hereby amended by inserting in the eighth line,  
4 after the word "made," the words "but the assessable  
5 cost of work so ordered and performed on pipe sewers  
6 shall not exceed two dollars for each lineal foot of pipe  
7 sewer; and all assessments for pipe sewers remaining  
8 unpaid at the date of the passage of this act shall be  
9 abated to such an amount that after the abatement is  
10 made the amount to be paid shall not exceed two dollars  
11 for each lineal foot of pipe sewer," so as to read as  
12 follows:—

13 *Section 2.* Any expenses incurred for any work so  
14 ordered and performed shall be paid out of the moneys  
15 appropriated under the provisions of section one of chap-  
16 ter three hundred and twenty-three of the acts of the  
17 year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and shall, to an  
18 amount not exceeding four dollars for each lineal foot of  
19 sewer, be repaid to said city, as the assessable cost of the  
20 work, by the owners of the several parcels of land bor-  
21 dering on the highway or strip of land in which the  
22 sewer is made, but the assessable cost of work so or-  
23 dered and performed on pipe sewers shall not exceed two  
24 dollars for each lineal foot of pipe sewer; and all assess-  
25 ments for pipe sewers remaining unpaid at the date of  
26 the passage of this act shall be abated to such an amount  
27 that after the abatement is made the amount to be paid  
28 shall not exceed two dollars for each lineal foot of pipe  
29 sewer.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
