[Bill accompanying the petition of the Harvard Musical Association for authority to hold additional real and personal estate.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-three.

AN ACT

To authorize the Harvard Musical Association to hold additional Real and Personal Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and
2 nineteen of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-five
3 is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. The Harvard musical association, a corpora-
2 tion chartered by chapter one hundred and nineteen of
3 the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-five, is hereby
4 authorized to hold, for the purposes for which it is incor-
5 porated, real estate and personal property to an amount
6 not exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
