AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MANDATORY RETIREMENT AGE OF SUPERIOR COURT OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
2 amended in order that those presently employed as Superior Court
3 Officers shall be allowed to continue their employment upon reach-
4 ing the age of seventy years; provided said officer passes a physical
5 examination performed by a physician selected by the Common-
6 wealth.
