AN ACT TO ADJUST THE SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF VETERANS'
SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 844 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following sentence:—There
5 shall be an officer to be known as the commissioner of vet-
6 erans' services, who shall be appointed by the governor for
7 a term coterminous with that of the governor, at such sal-
8 ary, not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, as the governor
9 and council shall determine, and shall devote his full time
10 during business hours to the duties of his office.
