AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPLICATION OF HERBICIDES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 6B of Chapter 132B of the
2 General Laws, as inserted by Chapter 722 of the Acts of 1981,
3 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-
4 ing: —

6 made to any land which is within 200 feet of a residential
7 home, water supply, wetland, or watershed area, or abuts
8 any privately owned land where the owner of said land ob-
9 jects to such spraying or application.”
