AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT TO
PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO EDITH P. BROWN, OF SWAMP-
SCOTT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation,
2 the town of Swampscott is hereby authorized to
3 appropriate three hundred and twenty-six dollars and
4 ten cents to reimburse the said Edith P. Brown for
5 damages suffered by her by the taking of land for
6 park purposes located on the Greenway, Swampscott,
7 and for taxes paid from nineteen hundred and forty-
8 two to nineteen hundred and forty-nine, erroneously
9 assessed against the said premises and paid by the
10 said Edith P. Brown.
