AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at
the State Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 state hospital, for the fiscal year ending on the thir-
5 tieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seven,
6 to wit:—

7 For the payment of salaries and wages, a sum not
8 exceeding sixty-eight thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws,
9 chap. 85; Acts 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1906, \$55,000.)

10 For other current expenses, including the cost of
11 printing and binding the annual report of said insti-
12 tution, a sum not exceeding one hundred and eighty-
13 two thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 85; Acts
14 1905, chap. 211.]

(Appropriation 1906, \$164,450.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
