AN ACT PROVIDING THAT FIREARM IDENTIFICATION CARDS BE ISSUED BY LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITIES TO PERSONS RESIDING IN FEDERAL INSTALLATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 129B of chapter 140 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 7 of chapter 799 of the acts
3 of 1969, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "authority", in line 2, the words: — or any person residing in an
5 area of exclusive federal jurisdiction, located within city or town.
