

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 3027

By Mr. McDowell of Dennis, petition of Peter L. McDowell and another that certain disabled persons be eligible for tax benefits afforded to senior citizens. Taxation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN DISABLED PERSONS BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BENEFITS AFFORDED TO SENIOR CITIZENS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A totally disabled person, regardless of age, shall  
2 be entitled to the same tax relief as a person classified as a senior  
3 citizen. Said disabled person shall be furnished with an identifica-  
4 tion card, as hereinafter provided, as proof of his disability. Any  
5 person or corporation furnishing a discount to senior citizens shall  
6 furnish the same privilege to disabled persons.

1 SECTION 2. The registrar of motor vehicles shall affix to the  
2 drivers license of a totally disabled person an identification mark  
3 or symbol as certification of the total disability of the holder  
4 thereof.
