Marshall for creation of the State Bar of Massachusetts as part of the judicial department of the state government and as an administrative agency of the Supreme Judicial Court and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 219) of Wycliffe C. Marshall for establishment of a self-governing association and as a part of the judicial department of the state government of all persons now entitled to practice law in this Commonwealth, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 1670).

Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Judicial Council relative to the Organization of the Massachusetts Bar.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to
2 investigate the subject matter of current senate docu-
3 ment numbered two hundred and eighteen and current
4 house documents numbered one hundred and thirty-
5 nine and two hundred and nineteen, relative to the
6 organization of the Massachusetts bar, and to include
7 its conclusions and recommendations in relation
8 thereto with drafts of such legislation as may be
9 necessary to give effect to the same in its annual report
10 for the current year.
