AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INCREASED PERCENTAGES FOR COMPUTATION OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out the table showing percentage of the amount of
4 average annual rate of regular compensation to be multiplied
5 by the number of years of creditable service and substituting
6 in place thereof the following:—
