AN ACT MANDATING DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE
REIMBURSE CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
- 2 law to the contrary, the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife is
- 3 hereby authorized and directed to reimburse medical bills
- 4 incurred by an individual whose dog or cat was injured by a
- 5 leg hold trap which is not registered.
