AN ACT

Relating to Small-pox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Section fifty-one of the twenty-sixth
2 chapter of the General Statutes is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the word forty-six the following:
4 “so far as they confer authority for the removal of
5 patients from their homes.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
