AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses
in the Office of the Land Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, for the year ending on
5 the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred
6 and five, to wit: —

7 For the salary of the judge of the land court,
8 four thousand five hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws,
9 chap. 128.)

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,500.)

10 For the salary of the associate judge of the
11 land court, four thousand five hundred dollars.
12 (Rev. Laws, chap. 128 ; Acts 1901, chap. 386.)

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,300.)

13 For the salary of the recorder of the land court,

14 four thousand five hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws,
15 chap. 128.)

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,500.)

16 For clerical assistance in the office of the land
17 court, a sum not exceeding forty-five hundred
18 dollars. (Rev. Laws, chap. 128.)

(Appropriation 1904, \$4,000.)

19 For sheriff's bills, advertising, surveying,
20 examining titles, and sundry incidental expenses,
21 a sum not exceeding twelve thousand five hun-
22 dred dollars. (Rev. Laws, chap. 128.)

(Appropriation 1904, \$13,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
