**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ARMORY COMMISSION TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF NATICK TO SAID TOWN FOR RECREATION PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The armory commission is hereby authorized to sell and con-  
2 vey, in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth to the  
3 town of Natick, a certain parcel of land in said town being lot B  
4 as shown on plan of land entitled: "Plan of Land in Natick,  
5 Massachusetts owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
6 dated January, 1964, W. A. Scheibl Chief Engineer of Public  
7 Works, being a Subdivision of Land Court Case 12461, Certifi-  
8 cate Number 36083, Southern Middlesex Registry of Deeds Land  
9 Court Book 242 Page 73, bounded and described as follows: —  
10 Westerly by Speen Street 339.55 feet; northerly by Lot A as  
11 shown on said plan 497.33 feet; easterly by three courses, 68.28  
12 feet, 160.84 feet and 192.59 feet, all by land of the Commonwealth  
13 of Massachusetts being part of lot C and all of lot D as shown on  
14 said plan and southerly by land of the Commonwealth of Massa-  
15 chusetts 770.59 feet. Containing 4.34 acres according to said  
16 plan.

17 The deed conveying said land shall provide that all right, title  
18 and interest therein shall revert to and revest in the common-  
19 wealth, if said town does not commence the development of said  
20 land for recreation purposes within five years after the effective  
21 date of this act.
