RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION AND EFFECTS OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT LAWS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chapter 50 of
2 the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-four, as amended by
3 section two of chapter 819 of the acts of nineteen hundred and
4 seventy-four, and most recently revived and continued by chapter one
5 of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-five shall, in the
6 course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of
7 current senate document numbered 1076, relative to clarifying and
8 amending certain environmental statutes of the commonwealth, and
9 current house document numbered 1967, relative to amending the
10 environmental impact law.
