In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE THE DUTIES OF AN INSPECTION OF  
WIRES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32 of Chapter one hundred and sixty-six as amended  
2 by Chapter five hundred and twenty-nine of the Acts of 1949  
3 is hereby further amended by adding after the word "thereof"  
4 the following paragraph: —

5 Inspectors of Wires appointed pursuant to this section shall  
6 not accept other employment which will impair his inde-  
7 pendency of judgment in the exercise of his official duties, nor  
8 shall he use or attempt to use his official position to secure  
9 unwarranted privileges or exemptions for himself or others or  
10 give the appearance of such action, nor pursue a course of con-  
11 duct which will raise suspicion among the public that he is  
12 likely to be engaged in acts that are in violation of his trust,  
13 nor shall he engage in or solicit any business of installing ap-  
14 pliances or wires used for signal, light, heat or power purposes  
15 within a radius of twenty miles of the City, Town, or District  
16 wherein such Inspectors of Wires have the authority to exer-  
17 cise legal discretionary powers as defined in this section and in  
18 Chapter 143, Section 3L.
