

Proviso. Corporation in ninety days after public notice is given, as provided for in the aforesaid supplementary act, any thing in said act of incorporation to the contrary notwithstanding: *Provided however*, That any proprietor, whose pew or seat may be forfeited as aforesaid, may at any time within one year thereafter redeem the same by paying the deficiency for which the same may have been sold, with interest and all costs that shall have arisen thereon.

CHAP. CXX.

An Act to annex Edmund Cleaves and William Cleaves to the town of Pownal

Persons set off to other town. Proviso. **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That Edmund Cleaves and William Cleaves, with their families, and about one acre of land, with the buildings standing thereon, be, and they are hereby set off from the town of North-Yarmouth, and annexed to the town of Pownal; and shall there exercise and enjoy the privileges, and shall also be subject to the like duties and requisitions of the other inhabitants of the said town of Pownal: *Provided however*, That the said Edmund Cleaves and William Cleaves shall be holden to pay all the taxes assessed upon them in the town of North-Yarmouth, prior to the passing of this act.

CHAP. CXXI.

An Act in further addition to an act, entitled, "An act directing the method for laying out highways."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That in all cases where any highway has been or shall be lawfully discontinued in whole
