In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS APPOINTED UPON APPLICATION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 282 of the acts of 1898 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence, as appearing in
3 chapter 674 of the acts of 1950, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following: — Every special police officer appointed under
5 the provisions of this act upon the written application of the
6 commissioner of public works of said city shall have the power
7 of police officers to preserve order and to enforce all laws,
8 ordinances, rules and regulations in force in said city pertain-
9 ing to abandoned automobiles, litter, and garbage, rubbish and
10 other refuse. A record of all appointments made under the
11 provisions of this act shall be kept in the office of the appoint-
12 ing authority; and any appointment so made may be revoked
13 by such authority at any time.
