AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS MUNICIPAL WHOLESALE ELECTRIC COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 775 of the acts of 1975 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the definition "Electric power
3 facilities" or "electric power facilities" and inserting in place there-
4 of the following definition: —

5 "Electric power facilities" or "electric power facility", any system
6 or facilities for the generation, other than by the use of nuclear
7 power, transmission or transformation of electric power and
8 energy, other than electric power and energy produced by the use
9 of nuclear power, by any means whatsoever, including, without
10 limiting the generality of the foregoing, facilities, other than nu-
11 clear powered facilities, for processing refuse or other materials
12 into fuel.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (1) of section 5 of said chapter 775 of the
2 acts of 1975 is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "energy", in line 1, the words: —, other than electric power and
4 energy produced by the use of nuclear power.

1 SECTION 3. Clause (o) of said section 5 of said chapter 775 of
2 the acts of 1975 is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "energy", in line 3, the words: —, other than electric power and
4 energy produced by the use of nuclear power.
