RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE SELECTION OF AN OFFICIAL SONG FOR THE COMMONWEALTH, AND INCREASING THE SCOPE OF SAID COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chap-
2 ter twenty-two of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-
3 one is hereby revived and continued. Said commission shall,
4 in the course of its investigation and study consider the sub-
5 ject matter of current senate document numbered 71, desig-
6 nating "Massachusetts, There She Stands" as the official song
7 of the commonwealth and current house documents numbered
8 1444 and 1445, to provide for an official state song.
