AN ACT

To incorporate the Trustees of the National Exhibition
of Horses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—*

1 SECT. 1. George M. Atwater, George Dwight,
2 James M. Thompson, William Stowe, John L. King,
3 and Joshua L. Briggs, of Springfield; David Aiken,
4 of Greenfield; Arthur L. Devens, of Ware, and
5 David Leavitt, of Great Barrington, their associates

6 and successors, are hereby made a corporation by the
7 name of the Trustees of the National Exhibition of
8 Horses, for the purpose of promoting the improve-
9 ment and breeding of horses, with all the powers
10 and privileges, and subject to all the duties, restric-
11 tions and liabilities, set forth in the thirty-eighth and
12 forty-fourth chapters of the Revised Statutes.

1 SECT. 2. The said corporation may hold real and
2 personal estate necessary and convenient for the pur-
3 poses aforesaid, not exceeding in amount thirty thou-
4 sand dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
