The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WORK HOURS FOR CERTAIN PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THE COMMONWEALTH, OVERTIME AND COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30A of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 626 of the acts of
3 1952, is hereby further amended by striking out the last
4 sentence as appearing therein and inserting in place
5 thereof the following:— All service in excess of eight
6 hours in any one day or forty hours in any one week,
7 rendered by an employee subject to this section at the
8 request of an officer of the commonwealth or other person
9 whose duty it is to employ, direct or control such em-
10 ployee, shall be compensated for as time and one half
11 the employee's hourly rate of regular compensation. The
12 basic compensation of persons subject to this act, estab-
13 lished upon its effective date, shall not be reduced by
14 reason of any provision of this act, nor shall this act be
15 construed as increasing the hours of labor of any person
16 subject thereto who, on its effective date, was required to
17 work less than forty hours in any one week.
