In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT AMENDING THE PRIVATE BUSINESS SCHOOLS ACT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to insure forthwith the application of
3 this chapter to schools teaching skills for medical, dental and
4 nursing assistants, and tractor-trailer operators, therefore it is
5 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 75D of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the clause "social skills,
3 habits, or customs", in the fifth line thereof the phrase: "medical
4 assistant, dental assistant, or nursing assistant skills, and tractor-
5 trailer operating skills."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
