

HOUSE No. 6061

By Mr. Shattuck of Pepperell, petition of George W. Shattuck that the Department of Youth Services be authorized to sell and convey to the town of Shirley certain land in said town for recreational purposes. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICE TO SELL AND CONVEY TO THE TOWN OF SHIRLEY CERTAIN LAND IN SAID TOWN FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of youth service is hereby
2 authorized and directed to sell and convey, in the name and on
3 behalf of the commonwealth, to the town of Shirley for recrea-
4 tional purposes for the sum of one dollar, land located in said
5 town located at the intersection of Shaker, Harvard, and Wilder
6 Roads bounded and described as follows: —

7 PARCEL 1

8 West side of Wild Road, bounded Easterly One thousand nine
9 hundred ninety-five (1,995) feet by Wild Road, bounded
10 Southerly by a dirt road unnamed, bounded Westerly six hun-
11 dred eighty-two (682) feet by Harvard Road, bounded North-
12 westerly One thousand three hundred twenty (1,320) feet by
13 Shaker Road.

14 PARCEL 2

15 East side of Wild Road bounded Northerly, Westerly, and
16 again Northerly by Fort Devens Military Reservation, bounded
17 Easterly, Southeasterly, Easterly, and Northeasterly by the
18 Nashua River bounded Southerly by the Lancaster Town line
19 being also the Worcester County Line bounded Westerly by Wild
20 Road.

1 SECTION 2. Title to the land described in section one shall
 2 revert to and revest in the commonwealth whenever such land
 3 shall cease to be used for the purposes set forth in this act.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVERSION OF CERTAIN LANDS

BEFORE THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN
 THE SENATE CHAMBER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, JANUARY 1973

ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN
 LEGISLATIVE COURSE AND IN THE PRESENCE OF THE CLERK OF THE SENATE

SECTION 1. The document of title to the land described in section 2
 shall be returned to the commonwealth in the event and on
 the date of the termination of the leasehold interest in the
 land for the purposes set forth in section 2, and the land shall
 revert to and revest in the commonwealth on the date of the
 termination of the leasehold interest in the land.

SECTION 2. The land described in section 1 is the land
 known as the land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
 located in the town of [Town Name], and the land shall
 be used for the purposes set forth in section 1.

SECTION 3. The land described in section 2 shall be
 returned to the commonwealth in the event and on the date
 of the termination of the leasehold interest in the land
 for the purposes set forth in section 2, and the land shall
 revert to and revest in the commonwealth on the date of the
 termination of the leasehold interest in the land.
