In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors by  
Innholders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section nine, clause second, of  
2 chapter one hundred of the Public Statutes, as  
3 amended by chapter ninety of the year eighteen  
4 hundred and eighty-five, is hereby amended by  
5 striking out the said clause and inserting in place  
6 thereof the following: That no sale of spirituous  
7 or intoxicating liquor shall be made between the  
8 hours of twelve at night and six in the morning,  
9 nor during the Lord's day, except that if the  
10 licensee is also licensed as an innholder he may  
11 supply such liquor to guests who have resorted  
12 to his house for food or lodging.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon  
2 its passage.
