AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WAREHAM TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO CERTAIN SCHOOL DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN PRIOR FISCAL YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the town of Wareham is hereby authorized to
3 appropriate money for the payment of, and after such
4 appropriation, the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized to
5 pay to Arlene Barrett, Judith Bruno, Elaine Butler, Sharon
6 Correia, Sandra DeLuca, Andrea Downing, Judy Govoni, Mary
7 Hogan, Beverly Lima, Gwendolyn Malone, M. Patricia Manuel,
8 Diane Post (Gleason), Lucille Roberge, Evan Santos, Patricia
9 Schaaf, Marjorie Shivvers, Jean Stadelman, Joan Wilson
10 employees of the school department of said town a sum not to
11 exceed twelve thousand six hundred and thirty-four dollars and
12 fifty-one cents in the aggregate for services rendered in the fiscal
13 year nineteen hundred and eighty-five, provided, however, that
14 the money so appropriated to pay for said services shall be raised
15 by taxation or made available from the unappropriated surplus
16 funds of the town.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the town of Wareham is hereby authorized to
3 appropriate money for the payment of, and after such
4 appropriation the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized to
5 pay to Linda Boucher, Elaine Butler, Joan Holway, Jacqueline
6 Schulze, Doris Westgate, Joanne DeGregorio employees of the
7 school department of said town a sum not to exceed four thousand
8 seven hundred and seventy-six dollars and thirty-eight cents in the
9 aggregate for services rendered in the fiscal year nineteen hundred

10 and eighty-six; provided, however, that the money so appropri-
11 ated to pay for said services shall be raised by taxation or made
12 available from the unappropriated surplus funds of the town.
