AN ACT REQUIRING AN INVESTIGATION AND CERTIFICATION BY THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY OF CERTAIN WELFARE APPLICANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 118 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 30 of chapter 658 of the acts
3 of 1967, is hereby further amended by inserting after the
4 word "parent", in line 13, the words:—if a female;—and by
5 inserting after the second sentence the following sentence:—
6 If the parent applying for aid under this section is a male,
7 the department shall require an investigation of his employ-
8 ment status by the division of employment security and a
9 certification by such division that he is unemployable before
10 any aid may be granted.
