## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

### AN ACT

To relieve Street Railway Companies of the Commutation or Excise Tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. So much of sections one hundred and  
2 thirty-three, one hundred and thirty-four, one hundred  
3 and thirty-five, one hundred and thirty-six and one hun-  
4 dred and thirty-seven of Part III of chapter four hundred  
5 and sixty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and six  
6 and all acts in amendment or codification thereof im-  
7 posing a commutation or excise tax on street railways is  
8 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the validity of any  
2 tax assessed or imposed on account of the year nineteen  
3 hundred and nineteen or previous years.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of January  
2 first, nineteen hundred and twenty.
