AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN FEMALES IN HOSPITALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 66 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in chapter 60 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by adding
3 after the word "evening", in line 14, the following: — , nor
4 prohibit the employment in hospitals of any female of eighteen
5 years of age or over on any shift which commences earlier
6 than eleven o'clock in the evening or terminates later than
7 six o'clock in the morning.
