AN ACT TO PROVIDE CONTINUING MEDICAL BENEFITS TO FAMILIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 118 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 4 of chapter 422 of the acts of
3 1982, is hereby further amended at the end thereof the fol-
4 lowing: —

5 Immediately upon finding a family ineligible for financial
6 assistance under this chapter, the department shall determine
7 the family's eligibility for medical assistance under section 1
8 of chapter 118E of the General Laws.
