AN ACT EXEMPTING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That the town of Braintree be exempted from those provisions
- 2 of chapter eight hundred and two of the acts of one thousand
- 3 nine hundred and seventy-two that apply to tenement houses in
- 4 the town of Braintree and that those provisions of chapter one
- 5 hundred and forty-five relative to tenement houses in force and
- 6 effect prior to the passage of chapter eight hundred and two of
- 7 the acts of one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two continue
- 8 to apply to tenement houses in the town of Braintree.
