Bill accompanying the petition of Ralph N. Butterworth and of others that the Metropolitan Park Commission be enabled to complete the construction of Winthrop Parkway. Metropolitan Affairs. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To enable the Metropolitan Park Commission to complete the Construction of Winthrop Parkway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission may
2 extend the sum of thirty thousand dollars for completing
3 the acquirement of land for a parkway or boulevard from
4 Winthrop parkway in the town of Revere to Winthrop
5 shore reservation in the town of Winthrop, said sum to be
6 in addition to the amount appropriated by chapter six
7 hundred and ninety-nine of the acts of the year nineteen
8 hundred and twelve for the purposes of said parkway.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenses incurred hereunder,
2 the treasurer and receiver-general is hereby authorized to

3 issue, in the name and behalf of the commonwealth,
4 scrip or certificates of indebtedness bearing interest at a
5 rate not exceeding four per cent per annum to the amount
6 of thirty thousand dollars, as an addition to the Metro-
7 politan Parks Loan, series two. Such bonds or scrip shall
8 be issued in such amounts and upon such terms, and
9 shall bear such rate of interest not exceeding four per
10 cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and shall be paid
11 serially in such amounts and at such times, within a
12 period not exceeding forty years, as shall be determined
13 by the treasurer and receiver-general, with the approval
14 of the governor and council, to be for the best interests of
15 the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
